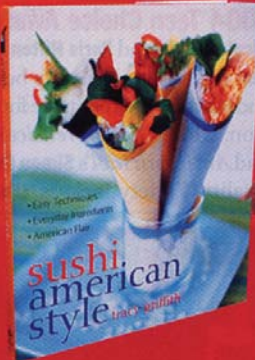

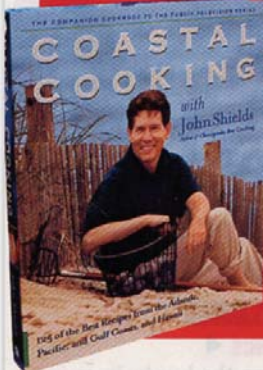


Coastal Cooking
